The units will be in five three-story apartment buildings. The project will include 10 HOME units (2 Low-HOME and 8 High-HOME) and 5 NHTF units.



To change Square D metering to American Midwest Power BABA Compliant would be an increase of \$102,434.25. Bringing total BOM cost to \$216,698.07. That would be \$126,105.00 in BABA compliant material which would be around 58% of the cost of the entire BOM.
